Open Positions: CPC is in need of a chair. It was mentioned one is needed to be in contact with the new jail that is being completed.

Election:

• Alt DCM – Jan H and Greg S both made themselves available and qualified. Jan received substantial unanimity with 18 votes, Greg received 6, 1 voting member abstained. Next month an election will be held to elect a replacement for the Treasurer position.

Reports:

o Secretary – Katie S – Motion to approve Minutes from November was made, seconded, and approved.

o Treasurer – Jan H – Motion to approve Treasurer's report (found on page 11 of December Newsletter) was made, seconded and approved. Gave brief year end overview of District 24's finances. Shared that we went over what was budgeted for the DCM and Alt DCM for the year, but this was likely because the District voted to cover their attendance at PRAASA. Let the District Members know that there is a 2024 budget meeting scheduled for later in December. Member asked if our prudent reserve will carry over to 2024. Jan replied that it will, although the agreed upon amount of the reserve may change as a result of the upcoming budget meeting. A member from Coffee Cup asked if their group had indeed sent in two checks for the same amount. Jan confirmed they did, as they had different check numbers. A member asked if District will be returning the money donated from the groups for the GSR scholarship fund. Jan replied that District does plan to return the money, but a discussion hasn't been had as to how or why that refund will take place. Another member asked if records had been kept of the donated amounts, Jan confirmed they had. Another member asked if the fund could be left as seed money for the upcoming year. Jan replied that decision would be up to the budget committee.

o Accessibility – Rachel T: No Accessibility report but encouraged members to consider standing for CPC chair. A member asked if Rachel had any information about a proposed program for AA homegroups to sponsor a remote community. Rachel said she will follow up on that question, as she didn't currently have any information about that program.

o Archives – Joyce B: Quarterly Report can be found in the December Newsletter on page 6. Said she brought physical copies of Mykala's business card for those interested in volunteering.

o Corrections – Justin D: Reported that he'd polled other Districts on how they were utilizing the funds they collected from the Pink Can program. The consensus was that those funds were being sent to that District's local Intergroup. It was deemed more beneficial to have the money in a large pool to draw from. A member raised concern about sending funds to Intergroup, sharing they'd heard there was an issue in the past about how Intergroup was using Pink Can funds in the past. Justin responded that to his knowledge, that was not the case. Greg, District 24's GSIG Rep, encouraged District members to attend GSIG's business meeting if they had any questions and/or concerns about how funds were being utilized. Glen, GSR for Gunny Sack Hill, shared his group had become aware of, and found sufficient evidence of the alleged mismanagement of Pink Can funds by Intergroup in an previous rotation. He shared that as a result of this experience, District 24 had decided at that time not to donate Pink Can funds to GSIG moving forward but to utilize them at the District level instead. Kelly recommended this issue be added as an agenda item for January.

o Event Coordinator – Claire W: Has reconsidered stepping down from position. She is requested an alt or co-chair to help her as she has several scheduling constraints making it difficult for her to hold the position. She requested clarification regarding speakers for the next Gratitude Banquet. She believed the tradition was to alternate yearly between alcoholic and al-anon speakers. This was confirmed. Claire also recommended having one woman and one man speaker. The 2024 Gratitude Banquet will be held on February 24th. Tamara volunteered to help co-chair the Gratitude Banquet.

o Grapevine/Lit – Debbie W: Spoke about upcoming Quarterly D24 is hosting this Saturday.

o Greater Seattle Intergroup Rep – Greg S: GSIG ended the year \$3,100 in the red. Contributions were lower than anticipated. GSIG had six 12 step calls, 115 chats via the website and 145 calls. Shared that the new edition of Our Stories Disclosed is out and available for purchase and that there is currently a sale on original Big Books, on sale for \$5 each. GSIG is also proposing a discussion topic: "Is an AA meeting an AA meeting just because it says it is? Or should there be some criteria set by Seattle Intergroup in order to be in our AA meeting schedule?" GSIG's Fall Assembly will be held on December 19th. Shared that two different budgets were up for consideration, which was apparently a controversial decision. Also shared that GSIG was considering changing their hours so they would be open on Mondays moving forward. Member asked what members who pre-ordered copies of Our Stories Disclosed should do to collect their purchases. Member was directed to the October Assembly notes for more information on how to get in touch about their purchased books, as the issue was discussed then. o Newsletter – Eric H: Confirmed that his employer is allowing us to print the Newsletter. He and his manager came to an agreement that he would bring doughnuts to his workplace once a month as payment and Eric will bring the doughnut receipt

- o PI Jeff K Was not able to attend Quarterly. It was an online Quarterly which was a recap of the year.
- o Registrar Dean K: Requested that new GSR's contact him to be added to the list. Asked if Eric could include the new GSR form in the upcoming Newsletter.
- o Schedules John M: Starting next month, he will meet w/ other Districts to discuss new schedules for April. Requested that if any meeting info is changing, that members e-mail him those changes (<u>Dist.24schedules@yahoo.com</u>). John donated 200 surplus old schedules to Lakeside Milam, has about 200 still left. Still has 400 current schedules available as well.
- o Third Legacy Jerry F: Beginning in January, he will be moving onto the Concepts. District 24 will go through all 12 by the end of the year.
- o Treatment Tammy K: Shared that she's been out of the loop for the last month, aside from picking up several Bridging the Gap forms from Evergreen.
- o Web Chair Desi H: Brought fliers for "Code for Recovery," (found on page 14 of December newsletter). Shared that the program had been vetted by the Area Webmaster and found to be legitimate. A member asked if the program was a non-profit organization. Desi explained that it's a volunteer group. Desi also gave an update on the website. Stated that it's not live, but that more of it is built.
- o Young People's Chair George: George is stepping down from position due to scheduling conflicts. Desi attended Quarterly, report in Newsletter (found on page 7 of December Newsletter.)
- o Zoom Coordinator Brian: May have technological issues with his laptop that will prevent him from continuing the position. Member requested the District consider purchasing a laptop so no one is prevented from performing the service position. Greg said he may have an old laptop he could donate.
- o Alternate DCM Lisa J: Thanked Kelly for her service, presented her with BB with cover and token as gift of appreciation. Asked any new GSR's/Alt GSR's to make sure D24 has their e-mail so they receive important info. Also brought old copies of Our Stories Disclosed for members to take for free.
- o DCM Kelly S: Brought literature for some of the Chairs, some pamphlets and small books. Shared that the info for storage unit will stay the same. Shared that she will be turning over her District debit card and new officers will be added after Treasurer election. Jan said she, Guy and Lisa can get new bank account set up, will add new Treasurer once one is elected. Old Business:
- o Bank account follow up. Waiting until after election to change account.
- o Dark meetings in District 24

to D24 for reimbursement.

- It was shared that there are 115 meetings in District 24 per week. Some of those meetings meet on multiple days during the week, so there are approximately 92 active meetings in total. Of those 92, only 17 participate at District.
- Glen shared that the Lynwood Alano club created an outreach committee to reach dark meetings at the club, of which only 2 attend District. Suggested the discussion be tabled until next month until more time could be spent on it.
- Kelly suggested creating an ad hoc committee to address this issue.
- Rachel asked for Glen to contact her about this issue (<u>Dist.24schedules@yahoo.com</u>)


