District Reports:

Secretary, Jerry F.: August Minutes were distributed by email prior to the meeting. Reading of minutes waived. Minutes approved.

Listing Chair, Susan C: Please contact Susan if (1) you are a new GSR or a new alternate GSR; (2) with any meeting changes; (3) you have not received your packet from General Service Office. There were three new members at the meeting: Mark S. Nora and Kristi for Susan C. to contact.

Treasurer, Virgil O. The treasurer's report from July 20, 2016 to August 16, 2016 was not in the September newsletter. Although the Treasurer's report was submitted to the Newsletter Chair, the report did not make it into the Newsletter. A copy of the Treasurer's report is attached to the Minutes to be published in the October Newsletter. Copies of the Treasurer's report were distributed and approved. Virgil reported that (1) The monies in excess of the prudent reserve were not disbursed. Last month a motion to disburse all monies above and beyond the existing prudent reserve as set forth in the existing District 24 Handbook was approved which means that the monies will be disbursed as follows: Western Washington Area 72 50%, AA General Service Office 20%, Sno-King Intergroup Office 20%, and Seattle Intergroup Office 10%. Virgil did not want to disburse the monies since there are some upcoming expenses related to the Assembly in October. (2) The picnic cost more than anticipated and was not self-supporting. (3) The Finance committee, consisting of Tari B., Rob G., Claire W., and Carol V., have been reviewing and approving budgets for the next two year term. They should have a recommended budget for presentation to the district for approval. The recommendations may include (a) changing prudent reserve; (b) lowering the gratitude banquet reserve; (c) lowering the picnic reserve; (d) changing how the prudent reserve is distributed. Prior to any of these changes, the GSRs will get the information to take back to their home groups and then the GSRs will vote on whether or not the existing handbook should be changed. No changes can be made, except for housekeeping matters, without a 2/3 majority of all GSRs and Elected Trusted Servants. (See the District 24 Handbook).

Alternate Treasurer, Claire reported that the budget is about ready to be presented for the review and approval of our home groups. Claire advocates that all District 24 Elected Trusted Servants get active and spend their budgets. The money is there to be used on the local level.

Public Information, Jim M.: Jim has a report in the newsletter. Jim thanks everyone who volunteered to help with the Public Information/CPC quarterly this month.

CPC, open: John K. was elected to fill this position until the end of the term in December 2016. Andrew R. was elected as alternate. Thank you John K. and Andrew R.

Treatment/BTG: Kathryn D. was absent.

Newsletter, Robert R.: The problem this month was that Robert can only work with PDF documents. The Treasurer's report was submitted in Excel. Robert suggested changing the format of the monthly minutes to take up less space in the Newsletter and save money on copy costs. No general consensus. Reminder: all materials for the newsletter must be sent to [dist.24.newsletter@gmail.com](mailto:dist.24.newsletter@gmail.com) at least seven (7) days prior to the district meeting, must be AA related and must be in PDF format. Robert will work with John K. to learn how to convert other formats to PDF. Robert will have the Newsletter out to all members by the Monday prior to the business meeting.

Regarding Flyers: Robert can attach pdf Flyers to the Newsletter. If you do not get a confirming email from Robert, that means he did not get your Flyer. Alternatively, you can send Flyers to the district 24 secretary who will distribute to everyone on the district mailing list.

Web Chair, Ron A.: Ron A. volunteered to fill this position until the existing term expires in December 2016. John K. volunteered to be a consultant. Thank you to Bob M. for his service. Thank you to Ron A. and John K. for volunteering to fill the position. Please contact Ron A. at [dist.24.webchair@gmail.com](mailto:dist.24.webchair@gmail.com) if there are any changes needed to the Web site. The address given for the district meetings still needs to be corrected.

Archives, Ron A.: Ron A. wants to thank everyone who helped District 24 host the Area 72 Archives quarterly. One of the highlights was a green copy of the big book distributed during WWII when there was no blue ink. Ron distributed a survey to GSRs about a new version of Our Stories Disclosed. Please take this to your home groups. Ron will be stepping down as Archives chair at the end of the existing term.

Alternate Archives, Annie N.: The Archives steering committee is meeting in Tacoma.

Grapevine, Rita: Rita will attend the quarterly which is being hosted by Districts 16 and 24. Rita encourages all GSR to take birthday envelopes to their home group.

Schedules, Mike B.: Please let him know of any schedule changes. He has forms to fill out if your meeting is not being published correctly. This is also a good time for the GSRs to review the schedule books and make sure that accessibility is correctly noted.

Sno King Intergroup, Chrissy A.: Chrissy reported that volunteers are needed to answer the phones, to act as 12<sup>th</sup> step coordinator, cellphone coordinator, archivist and office manager. Sno King is turning 25 in November and is hosting an open house on November 6, 2016 to celebrate. Sno King has tabled their plan to become a 503(c) organization until they are able to consistently keep a three month prudent reserve. Chrissy took Ed C.'s oral history. Discussion about storage options.

GSIG Zone Rep., Patty and Kelly co-chairs. Kelly reported about the ongoing efforts to expand the 12<sup>th</sup> step work that is happening at Virginia Mason Hospital. Both Swedish and Group Health are talking about starting similar programs.

Corrections, Lachlan L. Lachlan is just getting started. He has to re-file his forms to be allowed to take meetings inside the Monroe Penitentiary.

Accessibility, Carol V.: (1) Carol continues to pursue cohosting the January 2017 quarterly. Carole urged everyone to review their meeting space to determine if it is accessible and to make sure it is correctly identified in the schedules. (2) ASL funding continues to be a hot topic. What lengths, and at what expense, should AA go to provide access to the hard of hearing and deaf members? This dovetails with Carole's previous reports on our Spanish speaking members.

Third Legacy, Peg S.: Peg organized a presentation for each job that will be available in October for the new two year term. The positions that will be open for election are DCM, Alt. DCM, Treasurer, Alt. Treasurer, Recording Secretary, Accessibility, Archives, CPC, Corrections, Grapevine/Literature, Newsletter, Public Info., Registrar, Schedules, Treatment/BTG, Web, GSIG and 3<sup>rd</sup> Legacy.

Alt. DCM, Tari B: Assembly October 7, 8 and 9. Make sure to pre-register so that you are sitting with District 24. Make sure to get a hotel.

DCM, Tom L: Report in the newsletter. Assembly is in October. Discussed Assembly survival techniques and went over microphone etiquette. If someone has already made the point you wanted to make, do not repeat what they said. Remember, at the Assembly we will be electing new Area 72 Officers. Turn in your group survey regarding a new volume of AA Home Groups. Encourage your alternate GSRs to attend the next three district meeting so that they are up and running when January arrives.

Elections: Ron volunteered to be Web chair until the end of the year. John K. volunteered to help Ron A. as a consultant. John K. volunteered to be CPC chair until the end of the year. Andrew R. volunteered to help Ron A. as alternate CPC chair. Tom L. made a motion to approve this arrangement on an interim basis. Motion approved. Thank you one and all.

Old Business:

(1) Handbook Committee Update. Please contact Tari if you notice any mistakes or necessary changes to the handbook. For example, Archivist needs to be changed to a 4 year position. Secretary needs to be rewritten to make sure blind "cc" is used and to make it clear that the DCM not the Secretary is responsible for reporting to the Area 72 newsletter.
